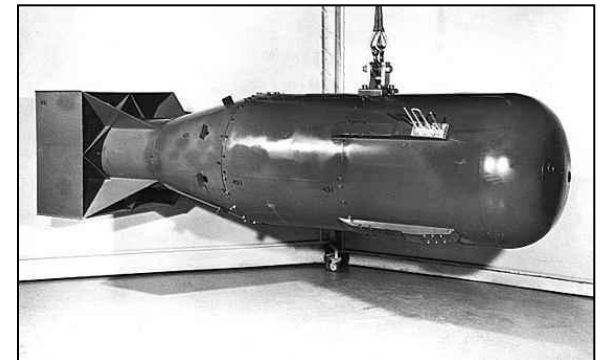

First Atomic Bomb (4)

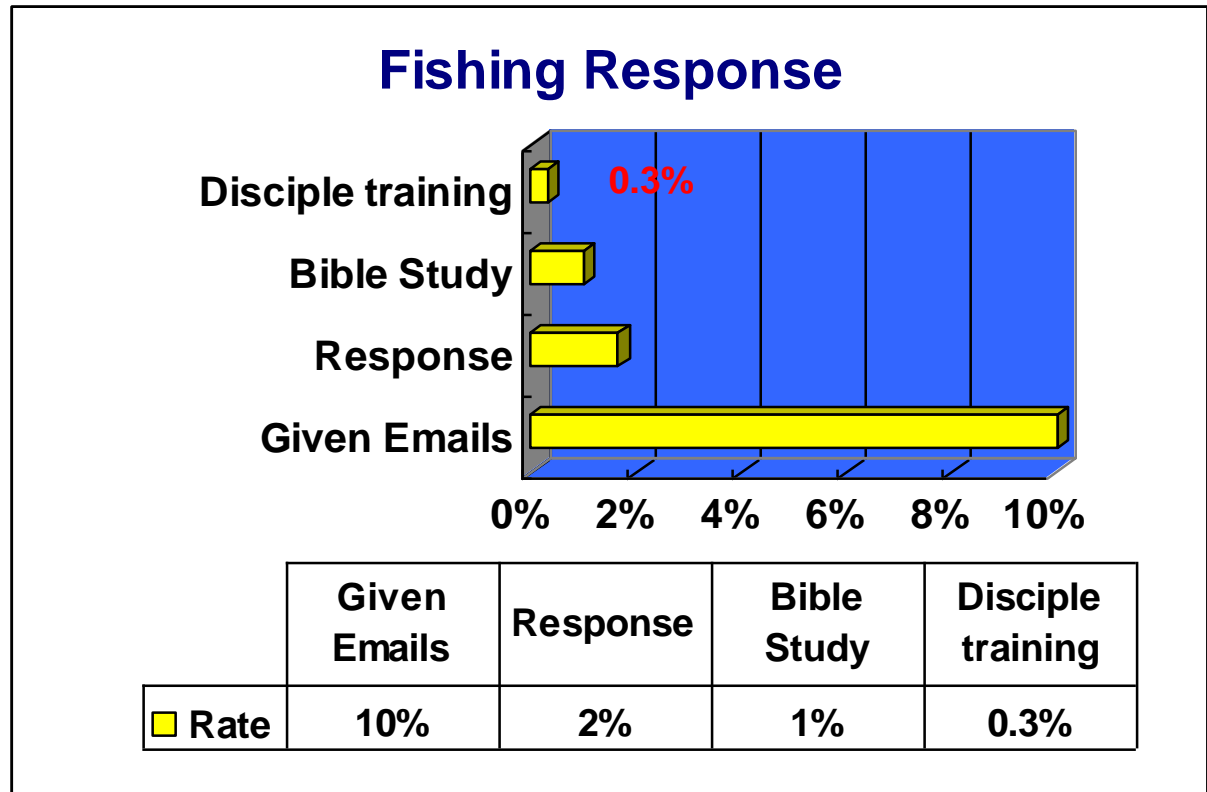
(1 → Test, 2 → Japan, 1 → Unused)

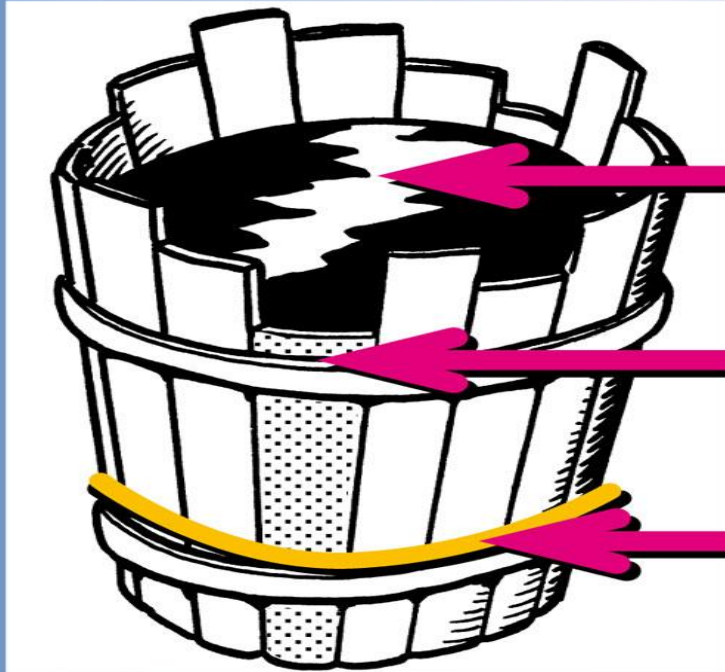
Check up on your spiritual progress (evaluation).

The shortest stave determines the amount of water the barrel can hold



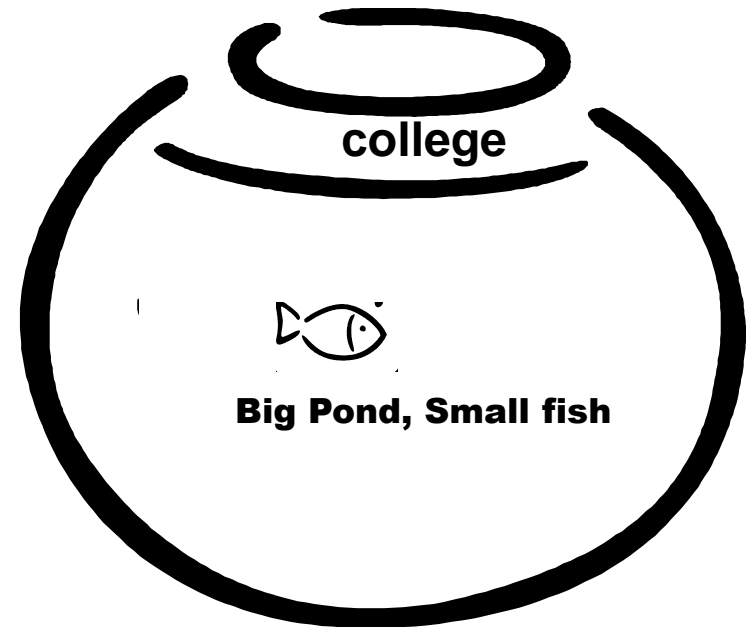
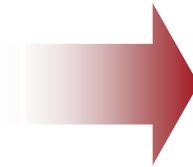
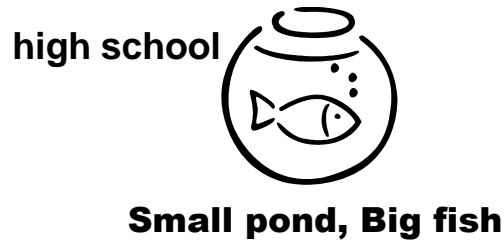

1) Disciple-making ministry

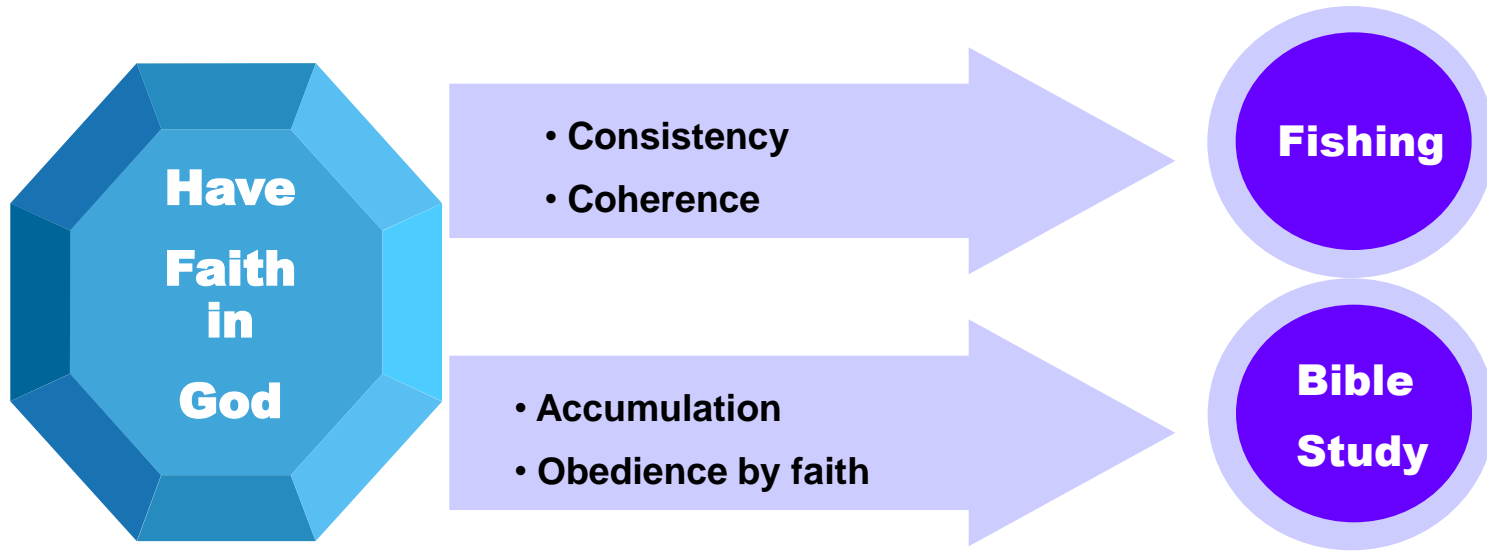
We have to have clear purpose to make disciples through our life-giving Bible studies.
